As a reward for exhibiting at the Sharp County Fair, youth exhibitors will receive a supplemental award providing they comply with the following rules.

Junior Exhibitor Eligibility

1. Member of a Sharp County 4H Club **OR** member of a Sharp County School FFA Chapter
2. Youth (19 years old & younger), never married, never had children, and enrolled in public **OR** private school **OR** home school in Sharp County
3. Must qualify for Sharp County premium money/points. You may not claim any other county as your home county.
4. Last year of Junior eligibility is the year graduating from High School or its equivalent or the same year exhibitor receives GED. For example: graduating in 2026, then 2026 is the exhibitors last year to show as a Junior exhibitor at the fair and receive Blue Ribbon

Blue Ribbon Qualifications

1. Exhibitor meets residential requirements
 - a. In County Criteria
 - i. Any youth attending a public or private or homeschool in Sharp County
2. Exhibiting one or more of the following species of Livestock
 - a. Beef & Dairy Cattle
 - b. Equine
 - c. Goats
 - d. Sheep
 - e. Swine
3. Meets pre-registration deadline
 - a. Submits entry forms in person or by email on or before the entry deadline of Friday, June 5, 2026 (***if mailed they MUST be to us by deadline***)
4. Between the ages of 5 years and 19 years old.
5. All Blue Ribbon exhibits must arrive & release according to the JR Livestock schedule.
6. Writes "Thank You" letters to Blue Ribbon Contributors
 - a. Must write a minimum of five (5) letters to contributors (letters to all contributors would be appreciated)
 - b. List of current year contributors will be available at the Sharp County Fair
 - i. Letter to contributors must have postage provided, self-addressed, and delivered to Mary Ellen Henley at the Ash Flat Livestock Auction on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays only
 - ii. Letters must be submitted by Thursday, July 23, 2026
 - iii. Letters will be taken to the Post Office per a board member at this time
7. Exhibitors will receive awards on their two highest paying exhibits

1. Beef Cattle exhibitors must have acquired title/registration and taken possession of the animal by May 1st of the current year.
2. All exhibitors exhibiting a registered animal in the Sharp County Junior Show must own the animal and provide original papers in the exhibitor's name.
 - a. Heifers without registration papers or not reflection ownership by exhibitor will exhibit as a commercial heifer.
 - b. Bulls without registration papers or not reflecting ownership by exhibitor will not be allowed to show. Non-registered bulls will be allowed to show.
3. All exhibitors exhibiting a registered animal in the Sharp County Open Show must provide original papers.
4. Registered Beef Cattle will show by breed of registration.
 - a. No registration papers required to place an animal on display at the fair.
 - b. No premium money will be paid.
5. Commercial Heifers will be divided into three divisions.
6. Cow-Calf pair classes are to exhibit a lactating cow with a nursing calf at side born after March 1st of the current year.
 - a. Classes will be determined by the Beef Superintendent.
 - b. Exhibitors must register for this at the time of registration for Junior Show due to **only** being a Junior Show class.
 - c. Calves at side are eligible to enter in regular classes according to their age or hip height.
 - d. Cows must meet requirements to exhibit in regular classes, if not they are only eligible to show in the Cow-Calf class.
7. Bulls of six (6) months of age or older at the time of the starting date of the fair will be required to have a nose ring and/or a nose clip with a lead securely attached to the ring or clip at all times. This is a requirement, not a recommendation.
8. Bred & Owned classes are to promote and recognize those exhibitors that are exhibiting calves they have raised.
 - a. Classes will be determined by the Beef Superintendent.
 - b. To exhibit in this class, the exhibitors name must be shown as the breeder on the registration papers OR a breeder certificate signed by your Sharp County Extension Agent or Ag Teacher or 4H Leader.
 - c. Exhibitors must register for this at the time of registration for Junior Show due to **only** being a Junior Show class.
9. Upon arrival at the fairgrounds the exhibitor must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection (health papers) issued within 90 days prior to exhibiting.
 - a. Any evidence of infections or contagious disease, or if external parasitism, and animals with active ringworm lesions (with the resulting of hair loss), multiple warts (easily visible without close examination), or atrophic rhinitis; will not be permitted to exhibit.
10. Exhibitors in Junior & Senior Showmanship classes for the Junior Show must own the animal they lead in for showmanship. Pee Wee exhibitors do not have to own the animal they lead in for showmanship.
11. The Beef Superintendent has authority to require removal of any exhibits as they deem necessary.

Bucket / Bottle Calf Guidelines

, Superintendent

1. Calf must be born after May 1st of current year.
2. Exhibitors must have acquired title/registration and taken possession of the animal by June 1st of the current year.
 - a. No recently purchased calves from a sale barn will be allowed onto the fairgrounds or to be shown.
3. Calf must be bucket or bottle fed, no nursing permitted.
4. Calf can be dairy and/or beef (purebred or commercial); can also be either sex (female or male).
5. Identified by either an ear tag, tattoo, or brand.
6. Exhibitor can show only one calf and must be able to lead the calf.
7. Classes will be determined by the Superintendent.
8. This class is not eligible for Blue Ribbon money.
9. Due to nursing requirements, calves may be released after the show.
10. Upon arrival at the fairgrounds the exhibitor must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection (health papers) issued within 90 days prior to exhibiting.
 - a. Any evidence of infections or contagious disease, or if external parasitism, and animals with active ringworm lesions (with the resulting of hair loss), multiple warts (easily visible without close examination), or atrophic rhinitis; will not be permitted to exhibit.
